SPECIAL EVENTS:

* **INTERGENERATIONAL PROM**

- Wednesday, 4/19 (3-4 PM, 5-7 PM, 7-9 PM) in the Cafeteria.
- Every year, we help out at the Intergenerational Prom: a dinner/dance for senior citizens. This event is A LOT of fun to volunteer at; there's amazing live music and awesome food for both guests and volunteers!
- This is a **MANDATORY** event for all Key Clubbers. You **MUST** sign up to volunteer at least one of the shifts.
- There are three shifts:
 - Shift 1 (3-4 PM): setting up the decorations in the cafeteria.
 - Shift 2 (5-7 PM): Guiding guests to the cafeteria, setting up food, helping guests get their dinners, socializing with guests during dinner.
 - Shift 3 (7-9 PM): continuing to help guests get food/dessert, helping give out raffle prizes, dance/socialize, cleaning up any trash, taking down decorations at the end.
