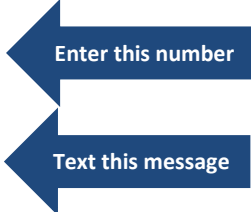
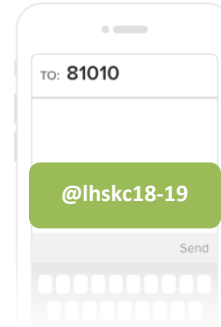

## \* **REGISTRATION**

- o If you're NOT going to Fall Rally:
  - o Step 1: Fill in the Key Club registration form online at [www.lhskeyclub.com](http://www.lhskeyclub.com).
  - o Step 2: Bring **\$25 check** made out to Livingston High School Key Club/cash (for club t-shirt and District + International dues for various services) to the meetings on **Wednesday, September 26** or **October 10**, or drop off the check after school in room E285.
  - o Note: The deadline to complete both is **Thursday, October 11**.
  - o **Please perform step 1 BEFORE step 2.**
- o If you ARE going to Fall Rally:
  - o Step 1: Perform steps 1 and 2 from above.
  - o Step 2: Turn in the Six Flags permission slip WITH a **\$47 check** made out to Livingston High School Key Club. If you want to go to Six Flags, you must hand in the permission slip **NO LATER THAN Thursday, September 27**.
    - You may turn these two items to our co-treasurers Aditya Desai and Avika Bansal, Mrs. McCorkell in room E284, or Mr. Ladolcetta in room E285.
  - o Season pass holders only need to pay **\$14** for the cost of the Six Flags Trip.
