  - If you're close but not quite at 25 hours, we encourage you to still submit an application on March 2.
- There are five positions that you run for: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Editor. The 6<sup>th</sup> position, Webmaster, is application **ONLY** and will be appointed. Remember, the written application is due **NO LATER THAN March 2<sup>nd</sup>** at the meeting.
