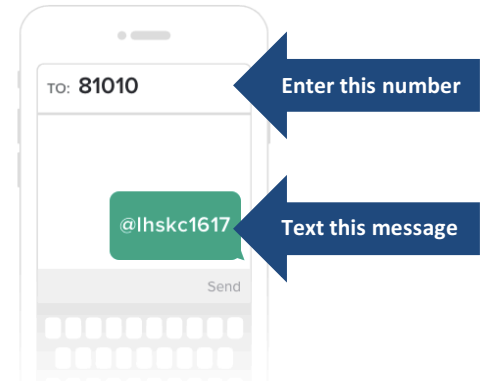

* **REGISTRATION**

- **IF YOU'RE NOT GOING TO FALL RALLY:** Please turn in your Key Club registration form and a \$25 check (Key Club dues) made out to Livingston High School Key Club by **Wednesday, October 19**.
 - The \$25 goes towards a Key Club t-shirt that you will wear to events and to Key Club International for various services.
- **IF YOU'RE GOING TO FALL RALLY:** Please turn in your Key Club registration form, Six Flags permission slip, a \$25 check (Key Club dues), and a \$45 check (cost of Six Flags Trip) no later than **Wednesday, September 21**. Both checks should be made out to Livingston High School Key Club.
 - You may turn it in to our treasurer Avika, Ms. Riggi in room E284, or Mr. Ladolcetta in room E285.
 - If you do not turn everything in on time, the cost of the Six Flags trip increases to \$50. If you want to go to Six Flags, the latest you can hand in the permission slip and check (the late due date) is **Wednesday, October 5**.
 - Season pass holders will only need to pay \$14 for the cost of the Six Flags Trip, but must still turn in the \$25 for dues along with the registration form and permission slip.

* **2016 FALL RALLY**

- On Sunday, October 9 at Six Flags Great Adventure, we have an awesome gathering of thousands of NJ Key Clubbers at Six Flags. It is \$45 per person. This year's theme is "Once Upon a Time in Key Club"!
- Permission slips must be handed in by **Wednesday, September 21**. The late due date is **Wednesday, October 5** (but see above for cost increase).
- We'll be leaving at 6:45 AM from the parking lot outside the cafeteria (teacher's lot). We'll return around 7 PM.
- Wear your Key Club Shirt to the Fall Rally!

* **EVENT SIGNUPS**

- Everyone can sign up for events on the LHS Key Club Website (www.lhskeyclub.com) under the "Signups" tab, or at meetings.
- The agendas (which contains all info about events) can be found on the homepage or under "Agendas and Flyers" in the "Signups" tab.
- Every full meeting attended will count as .5 hours of service. Remember, to uphold your membership status, you must attend 1 meeting a month and volunteer 2 hours a month. (***So in total you should have 2.5 hours each month.*** 😊).
