### \* **EVENT SIGNUPS**

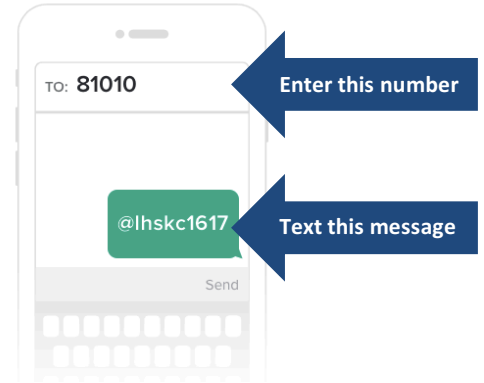

- \* **HARVEST FESTIVAL**
  - Sunday, October 16 (12:30-2:30 PM, 2:30-4:30 PM) at the YMCA.
  - There will be family fun, a food drive, a winter clothing drive, and short field trip to the Old Force Home garden. We need as many volunteers as possible, and please bring a non-perishable item and/or a gently used winter clothing item with you!

- \* **MIRACLE WALK**
  - Sunday, October 16 (6:30-8 AM Set up, 8-11 AM, 11-12 PM Clean up) at Verona Park.
